- ❖ Something raised from last week's meeting was that we do not have the Head teacher's award anymore or have many opportunities to celebrate successes. School Council suggested we could celebrate:
  - Work - Writing was identified as an issue by Ofsted in our last report therefore we could introduce a reward for good writing.
