

Bad Weather

In the event of bad weather, we always aim to ensure that the school remains open. Depending on the number of staff able to get to school we may have to re-arrange classes and cover that may be different to the normal school routine. Our priority will be to provide safe and adequate supervision for all children.

We will text all parents with news about the status of the school as early as we can and aim for this to happen before 8:15am. Information can also be found at www.kentclosures.co.uk as well as on local radio stations (Radio Kent, KMFM and Heart FM) and on the school website.

If there is a heavy snowfall during the daytime then we will only consider closing early in very extreme conditions and we will send a text. If you live some distance from the school and may have difficulty getting home then it may be possible to collect your child early. Please call the office to check if this will be possible.

Entry to school will be by the main gates only. Please be aware that the roads and paths leading to the school gates may be treacherous and you will need to take extreme care. Although we treat the paths in school with grit they may still have ice or snow on them so be very careful when entering and leaving the school grounds.
